It is a great way to continue their art education and learn about all of the preparation behind-the-scenes that goes into art programs for children as well as to stay connected to the Museum.

Volunteers work with teaching artists, museum educators, children, and fellow peers who have a serious interest in art. There is an application process, an interview and a mandatory meeting required of all volunteers. Volunteers can devote their time to either the entire summer season or choose a two-week session.

Each volunteer must commit to at least 6 hours/per week.
