TMA's 33rd Annual Holiday Artisans Market + Street Festival

November 16 – 18, 2018

The Tucson Museum of Art and Historic Block (TMA) 33rd Annual Holiday Artisans Market offers an expanded venue, more artisan booths, more hours, enhancing the annual market into an exciting street festival. New to this year's market and street festival, TMA is partnering with longtime supporter and next-door neighbor La Cocina, to offer more opportunities for visitors and feature a large line-up of live entertainment on three stages throughout the market and street festival.

This year's event features a Kickoff Celebration and Concert on the Corbett Stage from 5 - 7 p.m., on Friday, Nov. 16. The event is free and open to the public, offering late shopping hours, food and beverage for purchase, and a free music concert. The concert headliner is Amor Deluxe, featuring Gabriel Naim Amor on guitar, Thøger Lund on bass, a string section with Ben Nisbet and Samantha Bounkeua, Ben Degain on vibraphone, and Calexico's John Convertino on drums.

This year marks the 33rd Annual Holiday Artisans Market and Street Festival, an annual fundraiser for Tucson's oldest visual arts institution and a launch into the holiday season in downtown Tucson. Organized by TMA's Museum Store, the event features almost 150 unique and local artisans with crafts, original artwork, pottery, glass, jewelry, textiles, fine art, and gift items. The event will feature almost 15 concerts on three stages: Corbett Stage, Mooney Stage, and La Cocina Stage, throughout the weekend.

In addition to the market and street festival, admission to TMA's galleries is free for the duration of the market and street festival from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.; Neoglyphix, an indigenous art collective from will activate the corner of Meyer Avenue and Telles Street. On Saturday and Sunday TMA Learn, the museum's education department, will offer a family activity area in the Casa Cordova courtyard, where families can participate in free holiday inspired art-making projects including buttons, holiday cards, and ornaments.

About the Tucson Museum of Art and Historic Block

The Tucson Museum of Art and Historic Block's mission is *Connecting Art to Life*. The museum was founded in 1924 and is located in the El Presidio Historic District of downtown Tucson. It is Southern Arizona's premier presenter of fine art and art education programs.

The museum features permanent and traveling exhibitions of Modern and Contemporary, Native American, American West, Latin American, pre-Columbian, European, and Asian art. The 74,000 square foot museum offers guided tours and education programs. The museum's historic block of 19th and 20th C. adobe and Mission Revival-style buildings, encompassing a four-acre city block, includes the John K. Goodman Pavilion, the highly acclaimed museum restaurant Café a la C'Art, the Museum Store, and additional exhibition spaces.
